Guidelines regarding B. Com Assignment of Semester I/II/III/IV/V Examination for Candidates who already cleared B.Com. Semester VI Examination, 2020

1. One student will prepare one assignment for each subject/paper. (In Case of Microeconomics I & Statistics, E – Commerce & Business Communication, Macroeconomics and Advanced Business Mathematics, Student will prepare one assignment from each part/ module of that subject.)
2. Student can choose any topic from the subjects from the syllabus of respective semester.
3. Assignment should be hand written
4. Each assignment will be of **maximum 500 words**. However, in case of papers having two modules (Microeconomics I & Statistics, E – Commerce & Business Communication, Macroeconomics and Advanced Business Mathematics), assignment for each module will be of maximum 250 words.
5. Use **black ink** and write on **A4** size paper
6. Write C. U. Roll Number and Registration Number in each page.
7. After completing the writing of assignments students need to scan it and mail it in a **single PDF** to their respective **e-mail id**. PDF file name will be your C.U. Roll No.
8. The last date of submission is **3rd December, 2020**.

Topic of the assignments may be as follows:

For Semester I (Hons.) Examination (under CBCS) [Only for Candidates who already cleared B.Com. Semester VI Examination, 2020]

1. Microeconomics I & Statistics (GE 1.1 Chg) [Microeconomics I -Derivation of market demand curve from individual demand curve, Exceptions to the law of demand, Law of Variable Proportion, Perfect Competition.

Statistics -Methods of Collecting Primary data, Properties of Arithmetic Mean, Merits and Demerits of Standard Deviation , Concept of Moments, Skewness and Kurtosis etc]

Macroeconomics- Determination of Equilibrium level of National Income in Keynesian Model, Derivation of Government Expenditure Multiplier in the context of National Income determination, Derivation of IS curve, Concept of GDP Deflator, Demand pull Inflation and Cost Push Inflation, Policies to Control Inflation, Relationship between National Income and Gross National Product etc.

Advanced Business Mathematics-Theoretical concept of Function with an example, Definition of Limit with an example, Geometrical significance of Derivative, Definitions and types of Matrix with example, How do you find out a maximum value in a profit function and minimum value in a cost function? Explain with examples etc]
4. Corporate Accounting (DSE 5.2 A) [Issue of Shares, Company Final Accounts, Company Merger etc]

Contents of the Assignments may be as follows:

1. Cover page: This should contain **the name of the Examination** [B. Com Semester I/II/III/IV/V (Honours) Examination (under CBCS)] ,**Title of the Assignment, Name of the Subject, Name of the Candidate, Candidates university roll number and registration number.**

3. Features/ Objectives/ Merits/ Demerits/ Models/ Method or Technique / Any other theory of the selected topic.
4. One practical example of the selected topic.
