<b>Name of the Paper</b>	<b>CC/SEC/DSE</b>	<b>Credit Point</b>	<b>Course Outcome/Programme outcome</b>
Introduction to Political Theory	PLS-G-CC-1-1- TH+TU	6	The paper covers a wide range of theoretical issues relating to the basic structure of Political Science. Apart from the core meaning of the discipline it covers most of the theories of the state like Contract Theory, Liberal Theory, Marxist Theory, Gandhian Theory etc. Different aspects of Sovereignty are discussed. Basic concepts like law, liberty, equality and rights along with the ideational concepts of nationalism, internationalism and democracy have been incorporated in the course. Ideas of Marxism and Fascism have been dealt with in this paper. It also covers the functional aspects of politics like political parties, pressure groups and electoral politics.
Comparative Government and Politics	PLS-G-CC-2-2- TH+TU	6	The students are taught to discuss politics in a comparative perspective. Apart from the comparison of the different structural compositions of the Governments it discusses and compares the concept like federalism and the legislative, executive, judicial structures of different political systems. Special emphasis is laid on the Socialist Governments in this regard.
Government and Politics in India	PLS-G-CC-3-3- TH+TU	6	The students get to acquire a complete and comprehensive knowledge of the Indian Governmental structure and all the aspects of Indian political processes. It covers both the Union and State machineries engaged in governing the State. Political issues like castes, tribes, religion, class and regionalism and their roles in shaping the political discourse of this country are discussed in detail.
International Relations	PLS-G-CC-4-	6	The course enables the students to learn

Apart from the theoretical knowledge about the discipline, International Relations they are given exposure to both the history and the prevailing trends of international politics. They get to know about the different approaches for analysing international politics. Major issues like cold war and Détente are widely discussed. The course imparts comprehensive knowledge about foreign policy making with special emphasis on Indian Foreign Policy and its evolution and features.</p>

LEGAL LITERACY	PLS-G-SEC-3-A(1)-TH	2	The students are made aware of the important aspects of our legal framework. They learn about criminal jurisdiction, its evolution and related laws and their implications. They also learn about Indian Penal Code, its history, measures for protecting personal rights, laws related to offences (including marital offences). The issues of Consumer Rights, Anti Terror Laws, and Human Rights are exhaustively discussed.
ELEMENTARY DIMMENSIONS OF RESEARCH	PLS-G-SEC-4-B(1)-TH	2	The course virtually offers a training programme on “Research Methodology. The students learn about dependent and independent variables while conducting research. They are taught the techniques about framing research design related ethics and finally the art of Report Writing. The methods of data collection also are discussed under this course. A necessary knowledge of statistics is also imparted.
UNDERSTANDING THE LEGAL SYSTEM	PLS-G-SEC-5-A(2)-TH	2	Key issues relating to the composition of our Judicial System is covered by this course. The students get to know about development of some politico-legal trends like judicial activism, public interest litigation. Apart from gaining knowledge about administrative tribunals, subordinate courts lokadalats etc. They also come to know about election laws anti defection and similar provisions.
BASIC RESEARCH METHODS	PLS-G-SEC-6-B(2)-TH	2	The students are further trained about research methods like case study method, survey research focus groups etc. They get very important knowledge about experimental research and statistical methods. Content analysis and observation modes form an important part of any pedagogic endeavour. The students are equipped with such knowledge.

INDIAN FOREIGN POLICY	PLS-G-DSE-A-5-1B-TH+TU	6	Under this course efforts were made to acquaint the students with “Foreign Policy” and its determinants, as well as concepts like national interest, diplomacy, propaganda and military. The students get to acquire knowledge about Indian foreign policy and its features and her relationship with her neighbours.  .
FEMINISM: THEORY AND PRACTICE	PLS-G-DSE-B-6-2A-TH+TU	6	The course provides comprehensive knowledge about feminism including the concepts sex,gender, biologism and social constructivism. Issues of patriarchy are widely discussed. Special attention is paid to the Liberal, Socialist, Marxist and Radical feminist theories. Feminist critiques and feminist movements and other related legal issues are discussed.
