PROGRAMME: B.A. DEGREE COURSE(CBCS) POLITICAL SCIENCE GENERAL

PROGRAMME SPECIFIC OUTCOME

Students taking up Generic Courses under minor Arts and Science course commonly take Political Science as a Generic Elective subject under the CBCS system of curriculum. The syllabus is arranged in such a manner that the students can be oriented towards the core issues of Political Theory, International Relations as well as political dynamics of different types of states representing the ideologies of Liberal Democracy to Social Democracy. Besides Indian Constitution and political processes and institutions the syllabus also covers other aspects of the political system. The students who pursue other generic subjects like education, history and philosophy are likely to get enlightened about different educational schemes and technologies as well as methodologies related to education system. History course would enable them to explore our past in the context of modern method of analysis. The Philosophy too provides them with the intellectual tool for acquiring comprehensive knowledge about ideational tradition and philosophical perception. In fine after completing a General Course the students obtain sufficient knowledge for being eligible for different vocations.
