

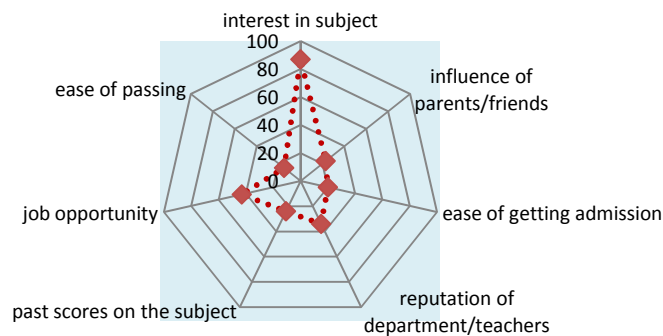
ANALYSIS OF STUDENT FEEDBACK ACADEMIC SESSION 2016-17

Online feedback response from students is collected with the objective of improvement of the teaching learning process and addressing the shortcomings. The questionnaire used for this purpose is exhaustive and covers different aspects including internal evaluation system, learning resources, college infrastructure, extracurricular activities as well individual and group relations within the institution. The following report presents a brief account of the general feedback collected online.

Choice of subjects

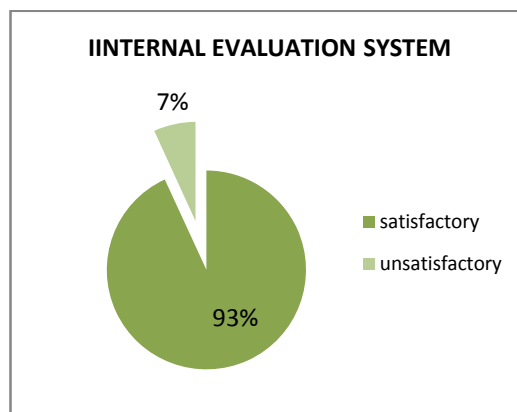
Feedback response regarding the factors that were influential regarding choice of subject shows that the deciding factor for majority of the students was their interest in the chosen subject. Job opportunities and reputation of the department/teachers were also important reasons for choosing a particular subject. However, it may be noted that many students were influenced by two or more factors.

Feedback regarding internal evaluation system

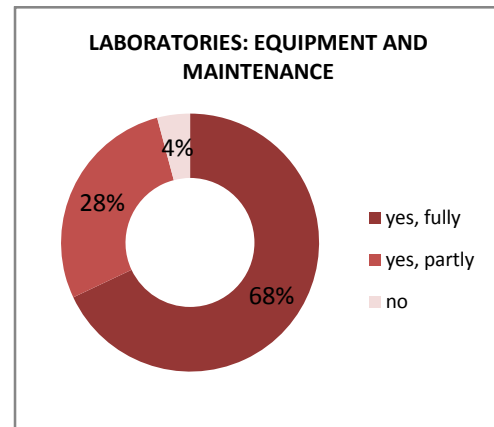
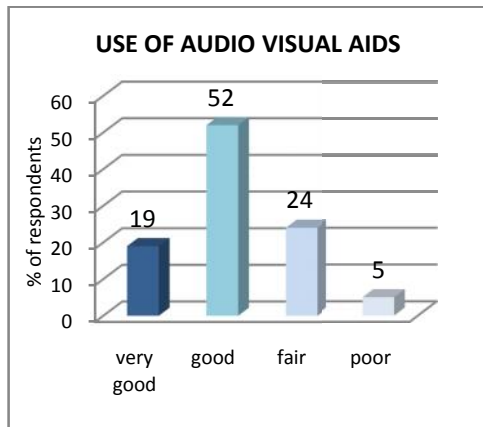
Opinion regarding the internal evaluation system of the institution shows that overwhelming majority (93%) of the students find the system satisfactory.



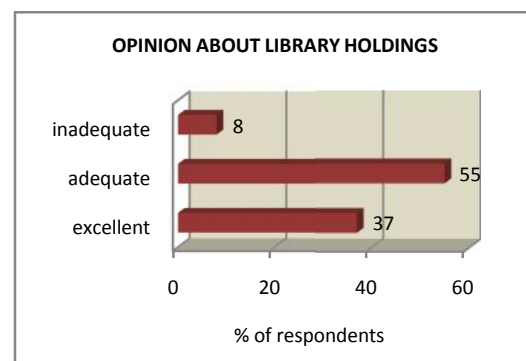
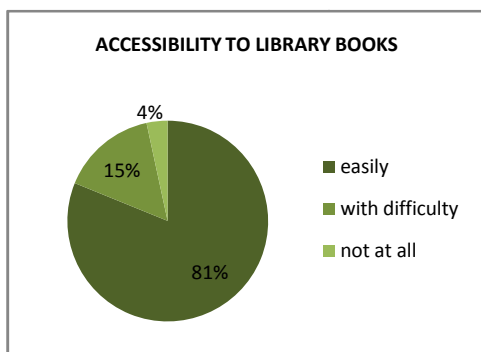
Feedback regarding learning resources

This section includes feedback regarding library and laboratory facilities as well as audio-visual aids

1. Use of audio-visual aids: Students appear to be moderately satisfied regarding the use of audio-visual aids in the classroom. About 19% find the use very good while 52% have feel there is good use of audio-visual aids. It may be noted that about 5% are extremely dissatisfied in this respect.
2. Laboratory facilities: About two third of the students feel that laboratory facilities are fully used while 28% feel that they are partly used and maintained.

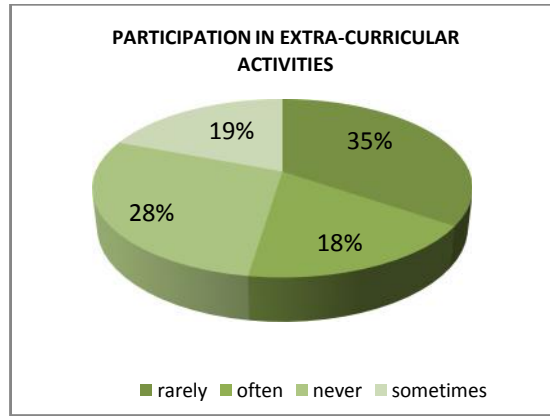


3. Library Facilities: student's opinion regarding library holdings shows a moderate level of satisfaction. About 55% of the students feel that there is adequate number of books available while 37% have expressed the opinion that library holdings are excellent. It may be noted that more than 80% of the students have expressed their opinion in favour of easy accessibility of library books.



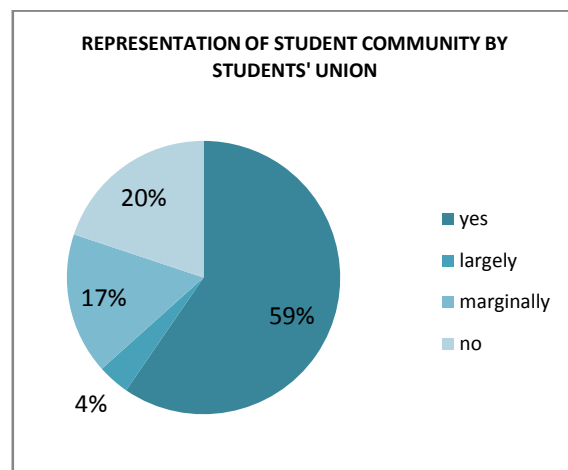
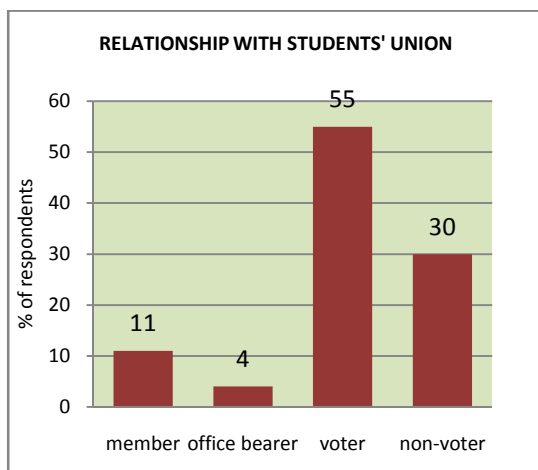
Participation in extra-curricular activities

Feedback analysis regarding students' participation in extra-curricular activities shows definite scope of improvement. More than 60% of the students participate either rarely or never in extracurricular activities. Only 18% of the students take part in such activities frequently and 19% sometimes.



Relationship with the Students' Union

Student feedback regarding the Students' union shows that slightly more than half the students participate in the process of election while 30% are non voters. About 60% of the students feel that the Students' Union is representative of the students while about one fifth of the students did not think so.

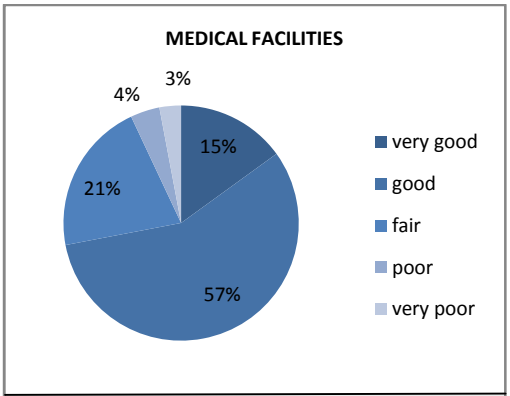
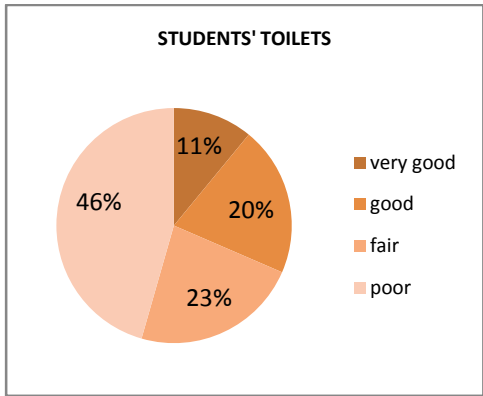
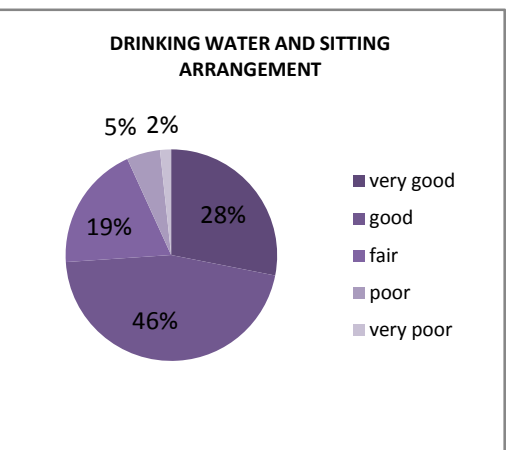
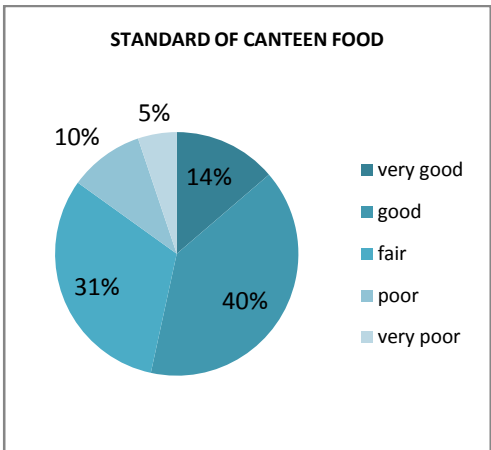
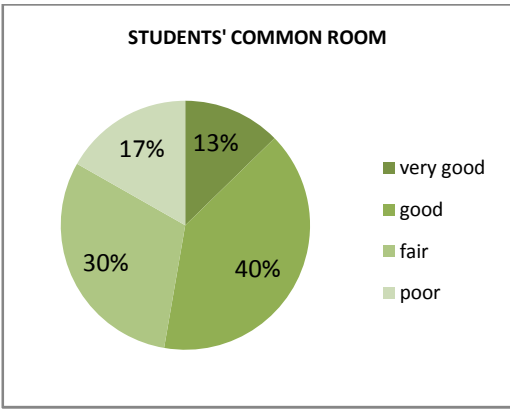
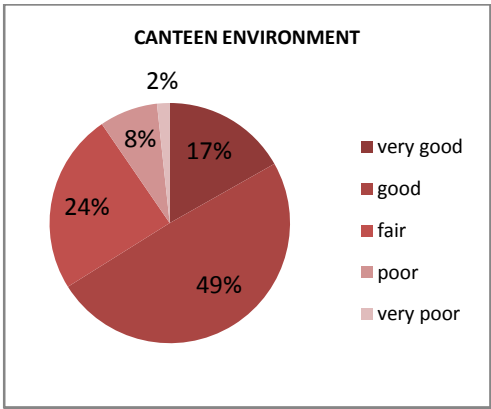


Feedback regarding college infrastructure

This section deals with students' perception regarding college infrastructure such as canteen, drinking water, common room, class rooms, medical facilities and so on.

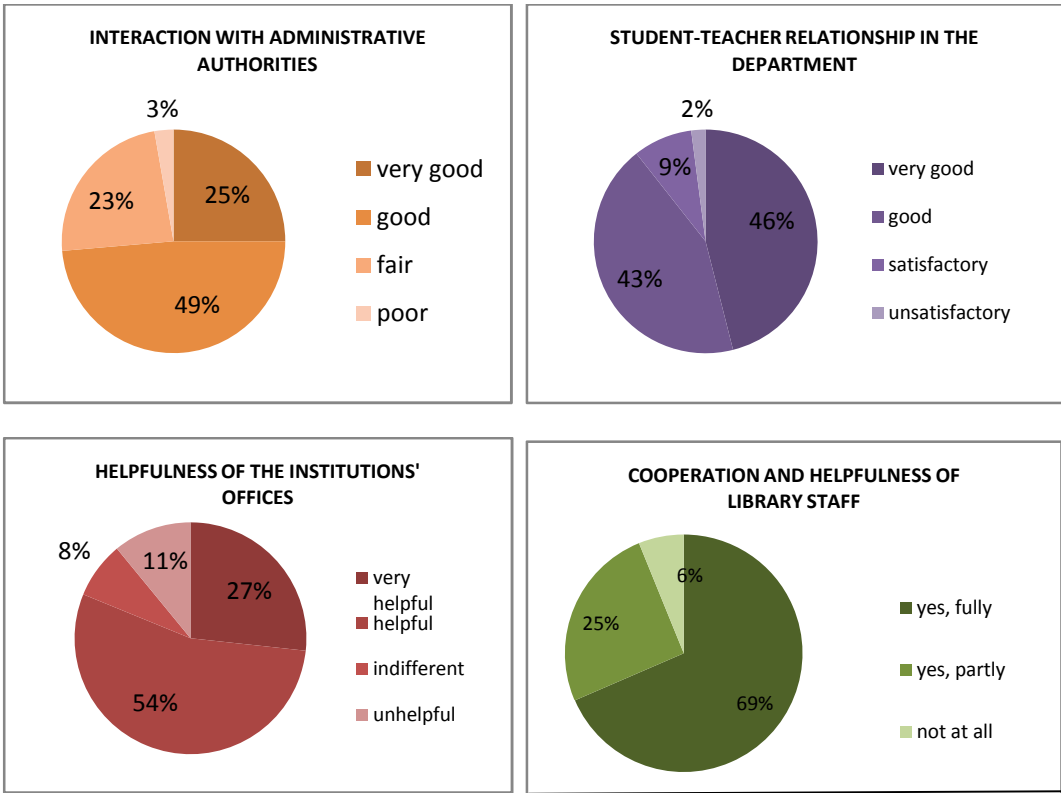
Analysis of the feedback shows that students are moderately satisfied with various aspects of college infra structure.

However, opinion regarding toilet facilities shows a high level of dissatisfaction among the students as 46% of the students have rated this facility as poor.



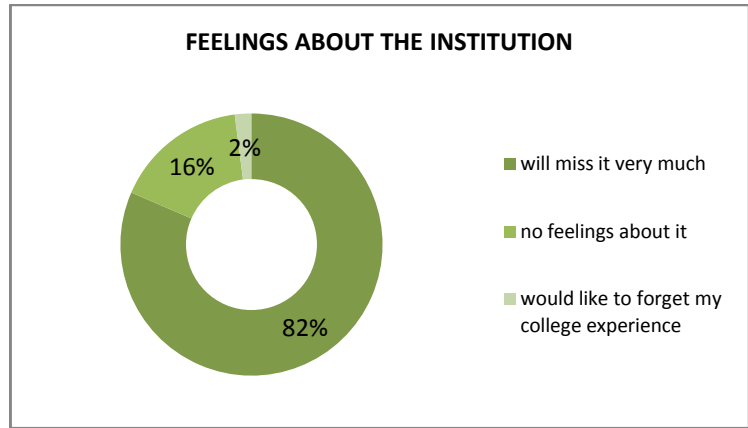
Students' relationship with the management, faculty and non teaching staff

1. Interaction with administrative authorities: nearly 75% of the students feel that interaction with the management can be categorised as very good and good while 3% are of the opinion that the interaction is poor or very poor.
2. Student-teacher relationship in the departments: students show a very high level of appreciation in this respect. 46% of the students feel they share a very good relationship with their teachers while 43% feel they have a good relationship.
3. Relation with the administrative offices. A moderately high level of satisfaction is expressed by the students and 54% of the students feel that the offices are helpful.
4. About two-thirds of the students feel that the library staff is fully co-operative and helpful.



Feelings about the institution

Analysis of feedback regarding students’ feelings about the institution shows a high level of satisfaction. Responses show that students develop close ties with the institution since 82% of the students have expressed the opinion that they will miss the institution very much after they leave.



Concluding remarks

Overall analysis of the feedback response collected from the students shows that students are mostly satisfied with the academic aspects though there is always scope for further improvement. The use of audio visual aids in classroom teaching needs to be done more frequently. Opinion regarding college infrastructure especially the canteen and toilets show that there is need for improvement. Student participation in extracurricular activities needs to increase and measures should be adopted to encourage students in this regard. The same is true of relationship with the Students’ Union. Students need to be made aware of the existence and activities of the Students’ Union. Finally students have expressed their warmth and deep feelings for the institution of which they are a most vital part.
