PROPOSED SHIBNATH SASTRI COLLEGE, CALCUTTA.

This College will be located at 23/49, Gariahat Road, Calcutta. It will be a morning College and will function from 6-45 A.M. to 11-15 A.M. i.e. for 6 periods of 45 minutes each.

The College will be affiliated in the following subjects and standards :-

Pre-University : English (Compulsory), Bengali (2nd subject), Hindi (2nd subject), Elective English, Elective Bengali, Sanskrit, Logic, Commercial Geography, History, Geography, Botany, Commercial Arithmetic & Book-Keeping, Elements of Economics and Civics.

B.A. English (General), Bengali (Compulsory), Hindi (Compulsory), Elective English (Pass and Honours), Elective Bengali (Pass and Honours), Sanskrit (Pass), Philosophy (Pass), Education (Pass), Economics (Pass & Honours), History (Pass & Honours), Political Science (Pass & Honours), Geography (Pass), Botany (Pass).

B.Com. (Pass): English, Bengali, Hindi, French, Economic theory, Economic Problems of India, Economic Geography, Secretarial Practice, Commercial Mathematics, Commercial and Industrial Law, Accountancy, Business Organisation, Advanced Accountancy, Auditing, Advanced Banking, Currency & Foreign Exchange, Secretarial Practice and Company Management.

We suggest that the library should be given more space by inclusion within it of the adjoining class room. The existing Common room for students may be shifted to the H.C. Mookerjee-Hall on the top floor and the space vacated may be utilised in arranging seminar rooms in two Honours subjects, say Economics and History. Two other small class rooms may be covered into seminar rooms, thus providing for the four subjects in which Honours teaching is being done now.

Governing Body

The Governing Body of the college will be composed as follows :

- 10 members elected by the Council of-Brahmo Samaj Education Society
 - 1 Principal, Secretary (ex-officio)
 - 2 Teachers' representatives
 - 2 Heads of the Institutions using the same building
 - 1 Co-opted member

Total 16 (sixteen) members.

Office

The College will have its own office under its own Principal. The Principal will be assisted by a Vice-Principal and a Bursar.

Pass standard of the Three Year Degree Course from the session 1961-62.
