Activities for sensitization of students and employees to social responsibilities: Providing aid to the people of the Sunderban affected by the cyclone Yaas.

On 26th June 2021, a team of teachers, non-teaching staff, students and alumni from Sivanath Sastri College, along with the Principal, Dr Runa Biswas, went to Sarberia to provide aid for people affected by the cyclone Yaas. Sarberia is part of the Sandeshkhali block of the Sunderban. It is more than 70 kilometres from Kolkata.

The cyclone wrought havoc and created immense destruction in and around the Sunderban area causing severe floods. Sivanath Sastri College, in keeping with its tradition of philanthropy, decided to extend a helping hand to those fellow human beings whose lives had been affected by this natural disaster.

Six faculty members along with the Principal, representatives of the Alumni Association, College NSS unit and few students visited Sarberia. Aid was provided for a hundred people rendered homeless by the cyclone who were being sheltered at Sunderban Sramajibi Hospital, which is run by the Sunderban Sramajibi Swasthya Prakalpa.

Grocery items like cooking oil, spices, pulses, sugar and soya nuggets biscuits, along with face masks, Phenyl, sanitizers were provided. A cheque for an amount of Rs 104000 as well as a personal contribution of Rs 16000 was handed over to the authorities of Sramajibi Hospital.
