ON 30TH APRIL 2019.

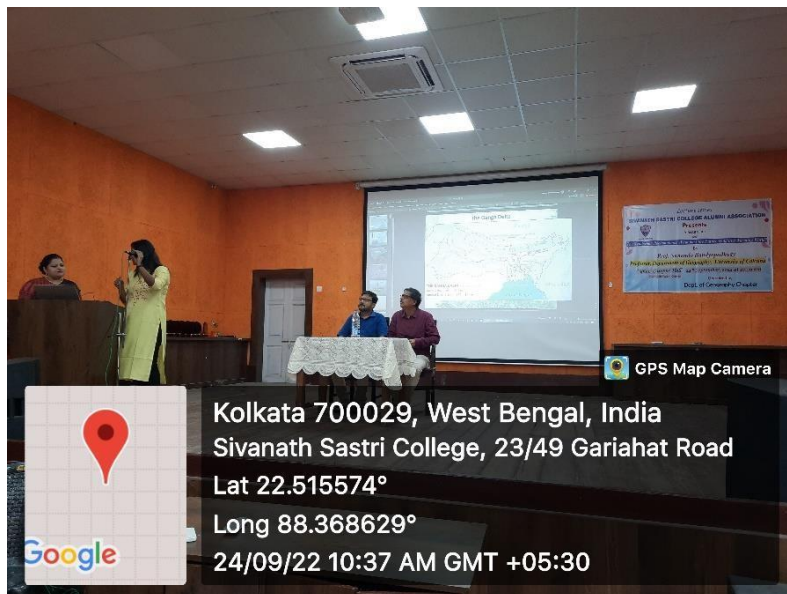
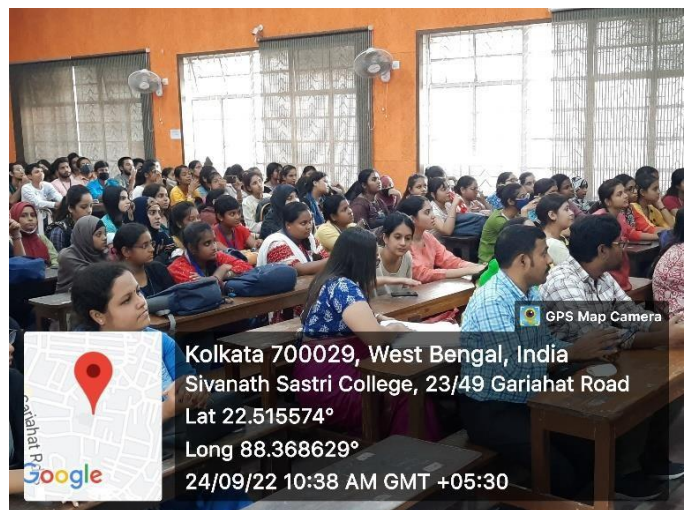
1. Three Workshops were conducted for the students on the 30th of April 2019. The Workshop on Cooking and Baking was conducted by Sukanya Maity. The Workshop on Jewellery Design was conducted by Monalisa Basu. The Workshop on Graphic Design and Comic Illustration was conducted by Priyanka Sen. They are all ex-students of Sivanath Sastri College, and are exploring alternative entrepreneurial means to become independent. Further, Priyanka Sen is an Assistant Professor at Barasat Government College and is also pursuing Graphic Design as an alternative career. The purpose of the workshop was to introduce the students of our college to alternative careers.

Students attending the workshop found the workshops useful in exploring careers that go beyond the stereotypical careers associated with their UG studies. The feedback received from the students was positive and they wished to follow up with the resource persons to further develop their skills in this regard.

ATTENDANCE: 61 girls attended the Jewellery Workshop, 73 girls attended the Graphic design workshop and 90 girls attended the Cooking and Baking workshop. The three workshops were conducted in parallel and therefore the attendance of each workshop was exclusive to it.

A total of 221 girls attended the workshops.

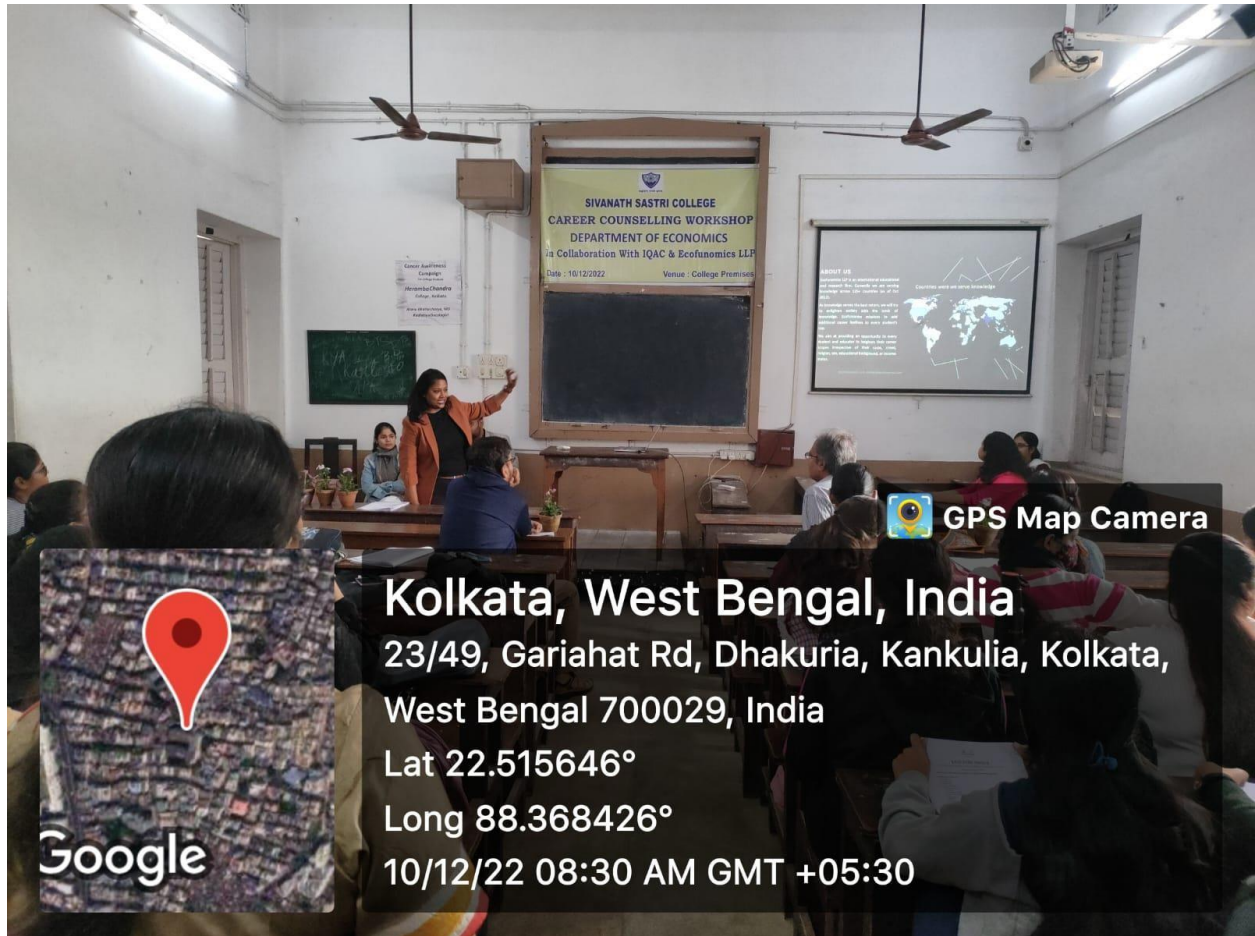
