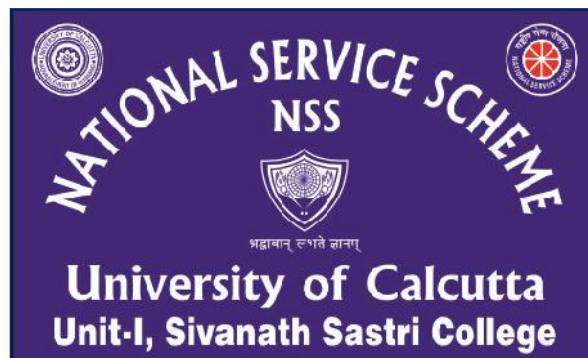


Sivanath Sastri College Unit I

NSS Activities for 2022 Annual Report

The NSS Unit is in operation in this college since 18.12.2015. The unit now registers 116 dedicated, enthusiastic, volunteers annually and takes active part in various programmes to serve the community.



Activities

The Earth Day Celebration: 22.04.2022



Volunteers of the NSS Unit of this college participated in a rally from our college gate to Basanti Devi College via Gariahat Crossing on 22.04.2022 to celebrate the world earth day. Participants included 116 student volunteers, 20 teachers and they were accompanied by four policemen. The students prepared and carried posters on the significance of this day.

Participation in Workshop on Sacrifice and Service: 12.05.2022



This one day workshop was organized at Swami Vivekananda's Ancestral House & Cultural Centre, Kolkata on 12.05.2022 and 3 teachers and two students participated in the workshop.

World literature day celebration: 08.09.2022

To celebrate the World Literature day the NSS Unit conducted a Socio-Economic and Demographic Survey in the areas surrounding Panchanantala and other slum Area, P.S- Rabindra Sarabar. Participants in the survey included 50 student volunteers and 8 teachers. They were accompanied by 4 policemen.



A questionnaire consisting of a set of 10 questions was prepared to assess the educational status of the residents of the slum areas and test their knowledge regarding freedom fighters and well known poets. Their perception regarding the necessity of education was also surveyed and the difficulties faced in this regard.

The responses showed that financial reasons are the major hindrances to education. Some of the respondents had primary education but were not able to study beyond the primary level due to financial constraint.

NSS Day Celebration: Dengue Awareness Programme

The NSS Unit organized A Dengue Awareness Programme at 20 Panchanantala (P.S.-Rabindra Sarobar) Slum Area for observed 24th NSS Day on 24 .09.2022.



Participants included 30 students and 8 teachers. The volunteers scattered bleaching powder and distributed phenyl among the families living in the slum areas. They also spread awareness regarding use of mosquito nets and that there should not be any standing water. The volunteers also informed the residents about the symptoms of dengue and informed them that in case of fever or other symptoms to contact the nearest health centre immediately.

World AIDS Day celebration: 01.12.2022

The NSS Unit organized a rally for 'World AIDS Day' celebration from our College gate to Basanti Devi College via Gariahat Crossing. Forty students and eleven teachers participated in the walk. The volunteers carried placards with slogans to create awareness on Aids and remove various misconceptions about the disease.
