**The College follows participatory management** in the regular function of the College. All academic policy and decision were taken in Six (6) Teachers Council Meeting held in the past year. Some of the policy decision was forwarded to the Governing Body for Approval. Two meeting with the Non-Teaching Staff were held to discuss office related issues and Administrative problems. Principal meet was done with all the Departments where the problem and aspirations of the student were shared with the principal in a closed-door meeting and their suggestion and grievance were properly addressed. Parent Teacher Meetings as decided in the Department meeting were held by all the Departments and Parent feedback was taken and an Action Plan was developed. All departments had more than four (4) meeting in one Academic Session and the Principal was present in one of the meetings by all Departments. Class Representative was chosen from the Departments.

The Alumni Association had several online and offline Meetings in the College. The Alumni Association was instrumental in organizing several academic and other programmes for the benefit of the students and staff. Alumni Contribution for “Renu Dutta” Scholarships was received by all the Departments of the College. The positive Contribution of the Alumni Association demands a word of praise from our end.

**Strategies adopted by the Institution in the past year for Quality Improvement:-**  
**Curriculum Development:-**

The University announced the introduction of NEP (New Education Policy)-2020 in next academic year. Several workshops regarding New Curriculum were organized by the College in Collaboration with Umesh Chandra College and Surendranath College by the Board of Studies and another workshop with Heramba Chandra College and Prafulla Chandra College. Many faculty members have also attended workshops on the New Curriculum in the other Colleges.

**Teaching learning and Curriculum Enrichment:-**

Regular workshop and seminar were organized by different departments like Education, Geography, Commerce, Economic, Political Science, History, English and Bengali which enhanced the teaching learning process. Workshop on Research Methodology – Identification of Research Problem, on Special Education, Museum visit, Gender Sensitization Programme. Students participated in inter college seminar, Lecture Series on Value Education, Career Counselling, Short term courses, Orientation Course and Refresher Course were done by several teachers.

The IQAC of the college in collaboration with the Departments had conducted workshops on Value – Orientation (Education Department), Career Counselling by (Education Department), Educational Excursions and Educational tours were organized by different Departments. Student Magazine “It’s Me”, College Magazine, Department Magazine by the Department of Bengali was published. Gender sensitization programmes were organized by Department of Education. A workshop on Research Methodology was organized by the Department of Education, Geography and Economics in Collaboration with Alumni Association. Teachers have always been enthusiastic in developing new strategies in Class room Teaching. Wall-Magazine, Peer Teaching, Group Teaching, Power Point Presentation is a regular feature towards enrichment of the Curriculum. Extended and Invited lectures have been arranged on cross cultural issues for Holistic Development of the students. The teachers are encouraged to pursue M.Phil and Ph.D programme and work on Research Projects funded by Renowned Organizations. No. of Books and Chapters have been published by many of our faculty.

**Research and Development:-**

The Research Ambience of the College is yet to reach the desired goals. The College funded and Project on Migration is an inter-disciplinary Research Project involving Departments like English, Bengali, Geography, History, Economics, Political Science and Women Studies. English Department had done an excellent job in their area of Research work.
