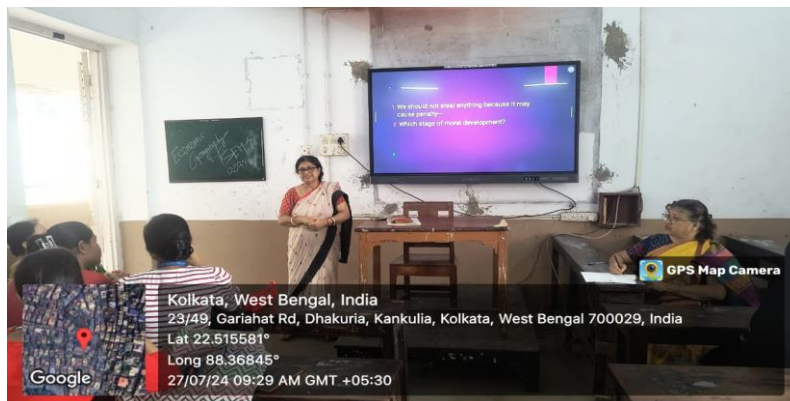

- 2) A **Student quiz contest** conducted as preparation for Semester end examination on 27th July, 2024 for the students of semester 2.

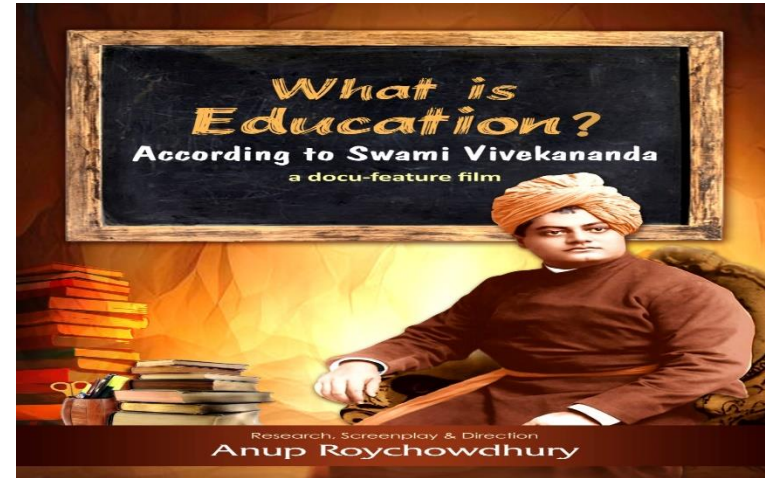

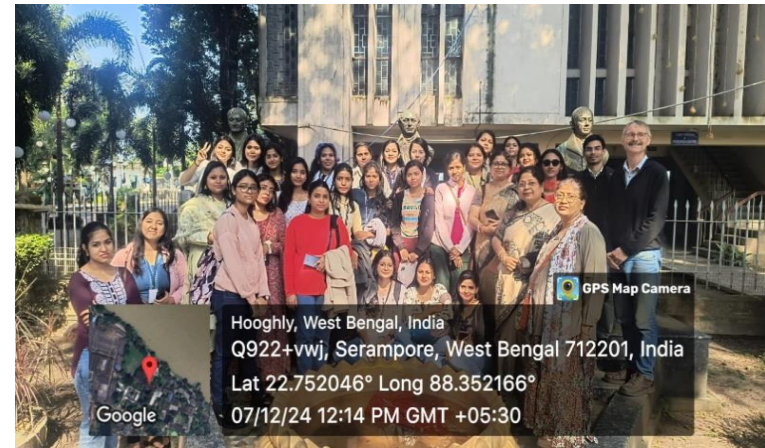
