UPDATE REGARDING ADMISSION IN STANDALONE MODE

This is to inform all students who had applied for admission in any course/category that in all courses except B.Com. (Honours), all students have been merit-listed and seats remain vacant. As such, students who had applied may contact the helpline numbers if they are interested in taking admission. Such requests must be submitted within 3.11.2025. No permission for late admission will ordinarily be given after 5.11.2025. Verification of any student taking late admission will occur on the next working date during College hours. If the student is unable to get verified within 7.11.2025, her admission will be liable to be cancelled.

In case of B.Com. (Honours), seats are available in all categories other than UR/General after completion of Merit Listing of all candidates. Students belonging to any category other than UR/General may therefore follow the procedure outlined above for obtaining admission to B.Com. (Honours).

In case of B.Com. (Honours) – UR/General category, all seats have been filled up and the list of candidates has not been exhausted. As such, first preference will be given to students awaiting merit-listing if any existing student cancels her admission prior to 5.11.2025. Only if admissions against such cancellations result in the exhaustion of the merit list for UR/General category shall students who missed their admission window be invited to take admission against any remaining vacant seats.

Since cancellations will be received from 29.11.2025, no further merit list will be issued in any course or category. Thereafter, i.e. between 29.11.2025 and 5.11.2025, merit lists may be generated only in B.Com. (Honours) – UR/General category on the working day following the receipt of cancellation from existing student/s. Any such merit list shall be generated at 2 PM and the payment window for such merit list shall be open till 10 PM on the same day. Verification of the student admitted under any such list shall proceed on the next working day after her admission. No separate notice will be issued for such merit lists or verification, and the students are advised to check the website and their email inboxes regularly. Rules and procedures for verification have been detailed in a separate notice.

The College security personnel shall not allow any student who has not been admitted to enter the College premises under ordinary circumstances. If any fit case arises for allowing the student to enter the College, permission has to be obtained through the Admission Helpline before coming to the College.
