## Publication of Seventh Merit List Against Fresh Cancellations Received on 1.11.2025 and Instructions Regarding Verification of Candidates on 4.11.2025

This is to inform students who have applied for B.Com. (Honours) – General/UR Category but are yet to be merit-listed that owing to the receipt of a small number of cancellations on 1.11.2025, the seventh merit list will be published shortly and will remain open till 10 PM on Sunday (2.11.2025).

If seats are not filled up, an eighth merit list may be published at 12 PM on 3.11.2025 and if it is published, admission window for the merit list will remain open till 10 PM on that day. The publication of the eighth merit list is contingent upon the availability of seats after the seventh list, and therefore no guarantee is provided regarding its publication.

Additionally, a fresh merit list for B.A. Bengali (Honours) has been published on 1.11.2025 and the payment window shall remain open till 10 PM on 2.11.2025. Students who had already applied through standalone mode for any course/category other than B.Com. Honours – UR/General Category may contact the admission helpline within 2.11.2025 if they wish to take admission to any course. Admissions thereafter will be contingent upon the University examination schedule.

All students who have been admitted in standalone mode, or will be admitted on 1.11.2025, 2.11.2025 or 3.11.2025 are to complete their upload of documents and generate their Enrolment Form through the College admission portal by 3.11.2025. Thereafter, they would be required to appear with all original documents, as well as photocopies of the documents, their Application Form and their Enrolment form in the College staff room at 7:45 AM on 4.11.2025. Verification will be conducted from 8 AM onwards and will continue till 8:30 AM. No verification will be done after 8:30 AM and any student who fails to

furnish necessary documentation within this window may be liable to have her admission

cancelled due to non-verification.

Owing to the start of University examinations from 4.11.2025, no cancellations will be

after 1.11.2025. Once examinations are completed on 19.11.2025, students who wish to

cancel their admission will be required to approach the College Office for the Transfer

Certificate (TC) and complete relevant formalities there. The Nodal Officer, Admissions and

the Admissions Team of the College will not be responsible for these transfer certificates.
