IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL APPLICANTS AND THEIR GUARDIANS

1. From the upcoming Academic Year 2026-27, the College is shifting to Centralized Admission Portal (CAP), to be operated by the Government of West Bengal. The details for CAP are provided on the first page of this document.
2. All queries relating to the procedures of the Centralized Admission Portal are to be directed towards the helpline/support email set up by the Government.
3. Details relating to the College eg. Course structures, fees, etc., are available on the CAP website. However, in case of any confusion, concerned persons may contact the helpline team of the College, whose contact numbers are given on the second page of this document.
4. Helpline numbers are meant for applicants and their immediate guardians/parents only. Queries from third-parties will not be entertained.
5. Queries from media houses/journalists must be made to the Principal. Information to the media will be provided only if permission is provided by the Principal.
6. No queries will be entertained beyond the specific hours mentioned against each person.
7. No queries will be entertained beyond the specific issues/courses mentioned against each person. In this connection, candidates are to note that separate personnel are assigned for B.A./B.Sc. Honours, General and B.Com. Honours. Queries regarding these courses are to be directed to these personnel only. The helpline numbers have been colour coded for easier comprehension. The Nodal Officer and Admission Sub-Committee Convenor will be available to take queries till 6 PM provided they cannot be solved by other helpline members.
8. Requests for contact numbers or emails of specific staff members, including the Principal, will not be considered. If required, helpline members will contact staff and faculty of the College on behalf of the applicants.
9. Since the collection of fees, along with refund/adjustment of the same for whatever reason are being handled by the CAP, the College will not be able to answer any queries pertaining to financial transactions associated with the admission process. Furthermore, the College authority will not be responsible for any financial difficulties that the candidates may face at any stage. Such queries may kindly be directed to the competent authority i.e. the CAP.

10. Cancellation of admission by the student, for whatever reason, will henceforth be handled by the CAP. As such, no queries relating to cancellation will be entertained by the College helpline team. Such queries are to be directed to the CAP helpdesk.
11. Admission to the College will be made provisionally on the basis of the documents submitted by the candidate. If, during verification of the same by the College at any stage, it is found that there is a mismatch and the student is ineligible for the Course or combination as per the rules of the University (University of Calcutta), the College shall reserve the right, the procedures of the CAP notwithstanding, to modify the combination of minor subjects or cancel the admission of the student and advise her to seek fresh admission on the basis of correct documents, in a later round (if available).
12. In case the College is unable to offer a particular combination of minor subjects owing to infrastructural or faculty constraints, students admitted to the College with that particular combination will be required to choose a different set of minor subjects. Refusal to do so may result in cancellation of admission.
13. College will not be able to modify the Major Course or subject, or the stream [B.A./B.Sc.] of a multidisciplinary course. Only minor subjects can be changed.
14. It will not be possible to change the details - Name, DOB, Category [General, SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B, EWS], marks or other details - at the College level at any stage during the application process. Changes, if possible, can be done only through the CAP website as per the modalities outlined therein. As such, no requests for modification of any details will be entertained by the College helpline team. Such queries are to be directed to the CAP helpdesk or BSK.
15. While the candidate is strongly advised to visit and check the CAP website on a regular basis for updates, the College will also maintain an admission page which will provide important notices regarding admission from time to time (as far as the College is involved). As such, students are requested to check the college website www.sivanathsastricollege.ac.in / www.sivanathsastricollege.org - regularly as well.
16. The final authority in all matters relating to admission will rest with the Principal, Dr. Runa Biswas.
